As mentioned in previous reports last year, theft from vehicles continues to plague us.

We have reports of two recent cases at schools where lap tops/phones/handbags have been taken. In each case there were no signs of forced entry. In one case theft from a vehicle in a remote area of the school. In the other from the school car park at the end of the day

You need to be very aware and in particular adopt a good common sense approach to this type of crime

- Park in a secure area if possible. The chances of theft with a guard present are lower, -although no guarantee. These people are quick , very practised, and blend with the environment .
- Lock your car- and make sure it is locked
- MOST IMPORTANTLY --Do NOT leave valuables on display , or obviously hidden (a jersey covering a laptop). Take them with you. Even if you are only going to be "less than 3 minutes"

BREAK IN REPORT FEBRUARY 2015

On 11/02/15 at 0400hrs in Avondale, an intruder jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, he stole a outside water tap, guard manning the premises saw him and he ran away. **The alarm did not trigger because there are no outside sensors.** Property has, burglar bars, durawall and manual gate.

On 17/02/15 at 1802hrs in Avondale, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, tried to force open the kitchen door, **the alarm triggered and they ran away.** Property has durawall, electric gate and burglar bars.

On 18/02/15 at 0440hrs in Northwood, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, went to the house and broke the computer room door, **the alarm triggered and they ran away.** Property has burglar bars, durawall and electric gate.

On 19/02/15 at 0350hrs in Alex Park, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, went to the pool and tried to steal the pool pump, the dogs started barking and chasing them, they ran away empty handed. **The alarm did not trigger because the pool area was not protected by outside sensors.** Property has burglar bars, durawall and electric gate.

On 21/02/15 at 2230hrs in Ashbrittle, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, they went and broke the borehole pump keys and failed to get anything. **The alarm did not trigger because the area had no outside sensors.** Property has burglar bars and a durawall.

On 21/02/15 at 1215hrs in Alexander Park, intruders bent electric fence strands which were not electrified and jumped into yard, they stole some items which were on the back verandah, **the alarm did not trigger because it was not armed.** Property has burglar bars, electric gate, durawall and electric fence

On 22/02/15 at 1657hrs in Eastlea, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, went and stole the gate motor and went away, **the alarm did not trigger because the area did not have outside sensors.** Property has burglar bars and a durawall.

On 25/02/15 at 0331hrs in Msasa, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, as they were approaching the building the guard manning the premises saw them and they ran away empty handed. **Alarm did not trigger because they are no outside sensors.** Property has burglar bars and a durawall.

BULAWAYO

On 05/02/2015 in Belmont area at 23:17:09 we received an alarm activation. Intruder(s) went through the roof but could not locate the alarm accessories and abandoned the criminal act. The alarm was armed and the premises are walled gated with a razor wire fence.

On 06/02/2015 in the CBD area intruder(s) gained entry into the premises and somehow managed to bypass the sensor. The intruder(s) vandalised 3 safes within the premises and a large sum of money was stolen as per clients report. The alarm Control Box and radio link safely concealed under a concrete stair case to the Director's Office & Accounts Office was vandalised.

MUTARE

On 19/02/2015 in the Murambi area at 23:48 hrs, unknown intruders cut a perimeter electric fence , the alarm went off and intruders ran away empty handed.

On 16/02/2015 in the Murambi area at 2100 hrs, unknown intruders gained entry into the house through unlocked door whilst the occupants were on the other side of the house, they stole property and got out unnoticed. **The alarm was not armed.**

On 15/02/2015 in the Chikanga area at 23:45 hours, 3 employees of a commercial firm were walking home when four male adult appeared and demanded cash and cellphones. The victims sustained few bruises from this incident.

On 13/02/2015 in the Avenues area at 22:40 hrs, unknown intruder found their way into a residential house through an unclosed window .The intruder was intercepted by the occupant and escaped with a cellphone. The house had no alarm at the time of breaking.

On 03/02/2015 in the Murambi area at 20:35 hrs, unknown intruders forced open a door to gain access into a lounge; the occupants heard noise and went to investigate. The intruders ran away and managed to steal some property which part of it was recovered by Response crew whilst checking the perimeter. The property has an alarm.

On 03/02/2015 in the CBD area at 00:30 hrs, unknown intruders forced open a screen gate and door to gain access into commercial premise. **The alarm triggered and the intruders ran away empty handed.**

On 03/02/2015 in the Fairbridge Park area at 23:13 hours, unknown intruders jumped over the durawall perimeter into the residential yard .The external sensors picked the movement and the alarm went off. **The intruders then ran away.**
